The Munster Juvenile U14-U19 Indoors Championships took place at the weekend. Out numbers were back on previous years mainly due to injuries but the club did very well, coming home with five medal winners at the weekend. The long jump was our main event of the weekend which accounted for three of the five medals reflected the work being out into that event. Aoibheann O'Brien was the big winner of the weekend coming third in the U17 Long Jump but she did it in style with a new PB of 5.11m and her first time jumping five plus meters. Rachel Bowler won silver in the Long Jump on Saturday with a mark of 5.01m. Nikolia O'Connor was appearing in his first Munsters and has been looking very lively in training all winter. He claimed is first Munster medal in the Long Jump also with a mark of 5.58m to claim second spot. Diarmaid Barry was our last medal medal winner of the day claiming bronze in the Walk. Sean Fitzmaurice claimed bronze in the shot U18 with a mark of 9.15m and jumped 10.57m in the TJ to come fifth. Ciaran O'Reilly narrowly missed out on a medal in the shot coming fourth with a mark of 10.33m.
